



PRE-SCHOOL GROUP – “We learn how to speak in Polish”.

On February 13th 2010, the first pre-school class will be held. This class will be for children ages 3 to 5 years. This course will be conducted by a professional with a Master's degree in pedagogy.

The semester is between February 13th and May 29th every Saturday, from 10:00am to 11:30am First Unitarian Church of Austin, at 4700 Grover Avenue, Austin, TX 78756-3108. We will not have classes on the Saturday before Easter, April 3rd.

Each class will be 90 minutes long.



Class time consists of:

9:55 -10:00 - drop off

10:00 - 11:20 – lessons

11:20 – 11:30 playground, pick up

As per agreement with each parent, we can provide a small snack during the course of each lesson.

The teacher will be available 10 minutes before and after each class period to discuss students’ progress and/or any question(s) regarding the individual child or the program. In addition, there will be an assistant teacher available for this age group.

All classes will be conducted entirely in Polish.



Children at this level will be taught through different methods of educational learning techniques; including singing songs, reading and discussing Polish literature, poems, and Polish fairy tales.

Didactic studies will strive for the development of competent language skills, enrichment of vocabulary, and correct intercommunication. Utilization of simple poems for children - their syntheses and analyses- will provide children with the logical ability to reflect in a foreign language. This class will prepare students for the next level in writing and reading in Polish. Methods of work used by the teacher allow for the comprehensive development of a child's social and intellectual abilities, as well as his or her artistic expression and motor skills.

The main idea for our class is to have fun – study through play!! We strive to create a joyful atmosphere. The priorities of this program are to learn the Polish language through fun, play, and social interaction.
